- General set up and assistance on Friday and Saturday. 2 hours shifts can be arranged.
- Help with registration and packet pickup on Friday, April 17th. Starting at 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. in Hobbs in front of the NMJC Admin. Bldg. 2 hours shifts available
- Run a Hydration Stations (tables along the course providing water and sports drink for racers). Times, locations and number of volunteers needed at each station will vary but there is lots of flexibility to fit your schedule. Service organizations and clubs are encourages to sign up to run a Hydration Station. Decorate your station to encourage racers and show your community spirit!!
- Distribution of hydration station supplies to groups manning the stations. 1 position in Hobbs, 1 in Lovington needed Friday and Saturday morning.
- Corner Marshals who direct runners on the course at corners and turns.
- Help with clean up after the race – Saturday, April 18th, afternoon in Hobbs at the finish area, or possibly along the course between Lovington and Hobbs - (several needed)
